We hope you all get well soon!

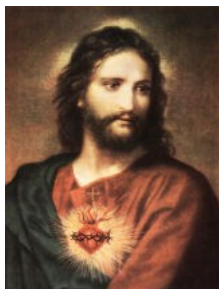

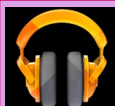
Troon Under 11's Cricket Training
