- Using multi—skills in invasion and team games.



Over the next few weeks we will be using the topic

'Set in Stone' as a basis for our work in class.

This unit is part of the Cornwall 'Inspire Curriculum'.



In Literacy we will:

- Compare and contrast a range of fiction and non-fiction texts
- Write information texts
- Use talk for writing techniques to write a fiction text

Pupils will continue to be encouraged to earn a pen license. In order to achieve this, handwriting must be consistently level 3 (neatly formed, legible and accurately orientated letters using the new style of font; clear ascenders and descenders with accurate use of upper and lower case letters; joined handwriting style with fluency and control)



In Numeracy we will:

- Mental addition and subtraction, multiplication and division
- Number and place value
- Written strategies for addition and subtraction, multiplication and division
- Using inverses to check our work
- Geometry: properties of shapes, angles, position and direction
- Problem solving, reasoning and algebra
- Measurement
- Fractions

In R.E. we will:



- Explore themes of peace and forgiveness This will include Jesus' teachings, and the sacrament of forgiveness.
- Learn about forgiveness through the story of Zaccaeus at the sacrament of Baptism.
- The life of St Francis of Assisi, the place of prayer in seeking forgiveness and peace.
- The multi faith teaching will look at the role of Muhammad as the last prophet



In History we will learn about:

- Archaeological evidence to learn about events in the past
- The impact of farming
- The skills and designs of early peoples
- The legacy of this period
- Chronology and ordering events
- Identifying anachronisms



In our language learning we will learn:

- Types of dwellings
- The caves of Lascaux
- Simple questioning and answering
- Extend knowledge of French phonics, and begin to read and write simple words
