- Develop our gymnastic skills

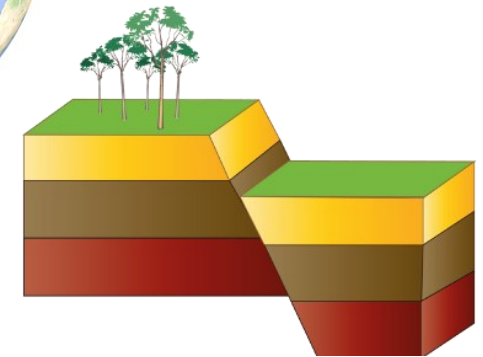
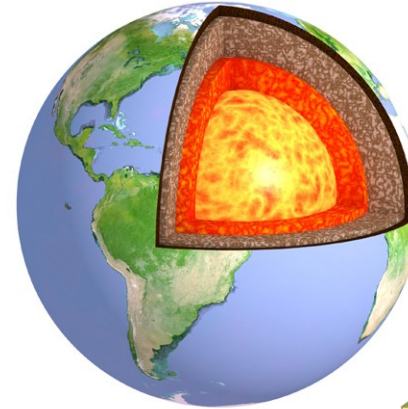
