- Having a week intense course learning to swim

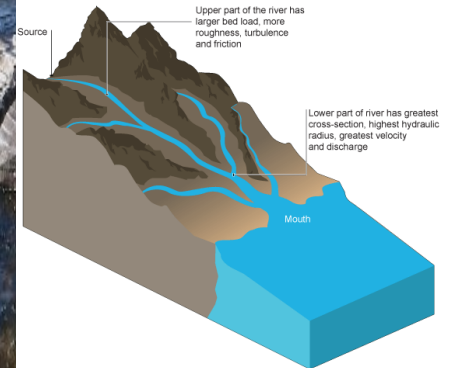

- Fractions and decimals
- Money

In R.E. we will:



- Explore more about the Holy Spirit, including the transforming power of the Spirit in the story of the conversion of Saul.
- Support the children who are preparing for the sacrament of Holy Communion
- Study the Eucharistic prayer that we say at mass



Science learning

- Exploring the difference between flowering and non-flowering plants.
- Learn about reproduction, and the role of parts of a flowering plant, including how water is transported through them.



Geography learning
