For the first half of this term we will be using the topic "What do I need to be me?" as a basis for our learning in class.

This unit is part of the Cornwall 'Inspire Curriculum'.

In Literacy we will:



- Learn a poem and recite it
- Change a poem
- Tell a story
- Change the details of a story but keep the plot the same
- Write a simple explanation
- Form our letters correctly
- Write the date and title on our books

In Numeracy we will:



- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100
- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally
- Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and solve missing number problems

In R.E. we will:



- Review our daily prayers
- Understand how God works through His people to protect His creation
- Describe what the Old Testament stories of Noah and Jonah teach us about God
- Explore how we can carry out God's work in protecting His creation
- Know that Old Testament readings at Mass help us reflect on how we carry on the work of creating and protecting the environment
- Explore how the Jewish Festival of the Harvest shows God as creator and protector

In Science we will:

- Investigate the lifecycle of a butterfly - looking after, feeding correctly etc
- Look at how we change as we grow
- Look at different animal life-cycles and explore how some animals change by just getting bigger while other animals metamorphose
- Describe how humans change as they grow
- Explore what humans need to be fit and healthy. Explore this through the healthy café
- Describe an environment for successfully hatching butterfly eggs
