Year Four

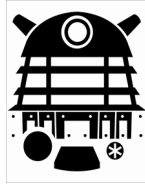
Summer
(2nd Half Term)

This half term we are going to be exploring the topic:

' Doctor Who '

In Literacy we will:

- Spend a week practicing descriptive writing emphasising adjective and adverb use.
- Write stories set in the Dr Who universe .
- Describe characters and settings using techniques to engage and entertain readers.
- Continue to focus on sentence construction and correct punctuation use.



Our first class book will be 'Matilda' by Roald Dahl.

In Numeracy we will:

- Continue to practice the times-tables up to 10.
- Develop the children 's understanding of the relationship between fractions and decimals.
- Practice ordering fractions and decimals and converting between fractions and decimals.
- Continue to develop the use of the written methods of calculation.



We will assess the children at the beginning and end of the half term, and will support them with the areas which require development.

In R.E. we will:

- Learn about Pentecost and its importance to the Catholic Church.
- Explore the work of the Apostles in the early formation of the church.



In Geography we will:

- Work with a partner to research a country.
- Present our findings to the class.
- Use our research to write a ' Guide to Earth ' for The Doctor to use on his visits.

In DT we will:

- Look at the different designs of The Doctor 's Sonic Screwdriver.
- Design and make our own Sonic Screwdrivers.
- Make models of the TARDIS (Homework).
