THE ANCIENT GREEKS



YEAR 5 AUTUMN 1

This half term we will be using the topic

'The Ancient Greeks' as a basis for our work in class.

In Literacy we will:

- Identify key features of Ancient Myths, exploring characters such as Perseus, Medusa and the Greek Gods.
- Write our own Greek myths.
- Read and analyse information texts about life in Ancient Greece.
- Research and plan and write our own non-fiction texts that explore our interests in the era.
- Create leaflets promoting Greece.



In Numeracy we will:

- Read, write, order and compare numbers to at least five digits and determine the value of each digit.
- Explain what each digit represents in whole numbers and decimals with up to two places, and partition, round and order these numbers.
- Use efficient methods to add and subtract whole numbers with more than four digits and decimals up to two places.
- Use understanding of place value to multiply and divide whole numbers decimals by 10 and 100.
- Multiply and divide a 3 digit number by a 1 digit number using efficient written method of short whole numbers and those involving decimals by 10 and 100.
- Convert between different units of metric measure (for example, kilometre and metre; centimetre and metre; centimetre and millimetre; gram and kilogram; litre and millilitres).
- Find simple fractions of numbers and quantities and explore patterns of equivalent fractions.



In R.E. we will:

- Compare and contrast the two stories of creation in Genesis.
- Explore the stories as a religious truth.
- Reflect on our God given talents.
- Visit St Paul's letter to the Colossians to explore how the people of God should behave.



In Science we will :

- Explore how the Earth rotates and how this explains day and night.
- Learn to describe the movement of the Earth relative to the Sun and Moon.
- Explore shadows.

In Geography / History we will:

- Locate Greece and the Greek Islands using an Atlas.
- Research Greek cities, rivers and seas using google maps.
- Learn about the achievements of the Ancient Greek civilisation.
- The legacy of the Greeks in sport, art, philosophy architecture and theatre.
- Explore Greek government and democracy.



In Art we will:

- Research the shapes and style of Grecian pots and then make our own inspired by the designs
- Develop delicate painting skills with different brushes.
- Exhibit our art work to others.

In Computing we will:

- Use the internet to research Ancient Greeks.
- Produce a document about a specific topic related to the Ancient Greeks.
